Important Tax Refund Information:

You will receive your tax refund faster if you choose to have it direct deposited with Blue Chip FCU. The direct deposit will be available IMMEDIATELY once we receive it from the IRS! You will need:

- Blue Chip FCU ABA Routing Number: 231381161
- · Your membership number
- · Must indicate if the deposit is for your savings or checking

If you choose to receive a check from the U.S. Treasury, those funds will be fully available to you; however, if it is not a U.S. Treasury check, a hold will be applied according to our policies to ensure your safety against fraud.

When making a contribution between January 1, 2020 and April 14, 2020, you will need to let the staff know if the contribution is for 2019. Recipe: Chocolate filled cupcakes

Cupcake: Mix all ingredients together. Spoon the batter into cupcake pans. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes.

Filling: In a small bowl blend the icing ingredients, adding enough milk for desired drizzling consistency, and drizzle over warm cake.

Ingredients Cupcake Ingredients:

2 cups sugar

- 2 cups flour
- 2 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp salt
- 2/3 cup Hershey's cocoa
- 2 eggs beaten
- 1 cup Crisco oil
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup boiling water

Fillina:

- ½ cup margarine or butter (DO NOT MELT)
- ½ cup Crisco
- 2/3 cup milk
- 3T flour
- 1/2 3/4 cup sugar
 - 1 tsp vanilla

Create a monthly budget and stick to it:
